It is with the greatest pleasure that I invite you and your students to our 13th MUNA conference next year. The conference dates have been set on 20th, 21st and 22nd of February 2018. The MUNA theme will be: Beyond Borders – “I was here” –. After signing up for MUNA 2018 we will provide further information on the MUNA theme and charity for 2018.

Housing

Students from foreign schools are welcome to stay with host families from Monday evening to Friday morning if the school desires to. Schools that want to arrive sooner and participate in additional excursions can discuss details with the chair of the MUNA board, Mr. de Haas, via board@munalfrink.nl. Staying after the 22nd of February is possible, albeit fully at your own expense and responsibility hence without any guidance from MUNA. but this will be without the assistance of MUNA staff members, as their spring break starts Friday afternoon after MUNA and many Alfrink pupils will go on a holiday trip. The MUNA staff offers their assistance in finding accommodation and helping to organise excursions. We have good experiences with the Youth Hostel in The Hague. Number of delegates

There is no pre-decided number of delegates every school is allowed to bring to MUNA 2018. This is the case since the requested number of delegates often greatly varies between schools. Hence, in the registration form, schools can fill in the preferred number of delegates. After having received all applications we will correspond the definite number of delegates your school may bring. It is important to keep in mind that your desired number of participants may differ from the assigned number. Please note that there is a possibility of a surplus of foreign students. Although we strive to house all delegates with a Dutch student, we will inform you timely with further details when necessary.

Application for student-officers (chairs) at MUNA 2018

Your students are invited to either apply as Student Officers to chair a committee, or to join the Press Team as a writer or photographer. This application procedure is explained in another document attached to this mail. We have a tight deadline with the chair applications. The deadline for applying as a chair for MUNA 2018 is the **1st of September 2017**. Please inform your students about the deadline and refer them to the application form which you will find attached to this mail.

If one of your students is interested in participating in our Press Team they can send a motivation letter, accompanied by a recommendation letter from their MUN director, to the Secretary General of MUNA 2018, Thomas Groenink, at sgmuna@live.nl.
